NEW Programs and Professional Opportunities at MCS


Mater Christi School will be offering an extended summer program for preschool students beginning this July. Look for more program and registration information coming soon!



In today's Gospel Mark 1:21-28. The scene begins with




Jesus entering the synagogue on the Sabbath, and immediately, the people are astonished at his teaching. What sets Jesus apart is not just the eloquence of his words, but the authority with which he speaks. As we reflect on this passage,

let us delve into the significance of Jesus' authority. In the Jewish tradition, teaching with authority meant more than just knowledge; it implied a divine endorsement. Jesus wasn't merely conveying information; he was proclaiming the very Word of God. His words carried weight and power because they originated from a source beyond human understanding. The people in the synagogue were astounded not only by Jesus' words but also by his actions. Suddenly, a man possessed by an unclean spirit appears, and the confrontation between the demonic realm and the divine authority of Jesus unfolds. With a mere command, Jesus rebukes the unclean spirit, and the man is set free. The people witness firsthand the authority of Jesus over the forces of darkness. In our lives, we encounter various challenges, struggles, and moments of darkness. The authority of Jesus is not a relic of the past; it is a living reality that continues to break the chains of sin and oppression. Just as Jesus liberated the man in the synagogue, he can liberate us from the burdens that bind us. The question for us today is, do we allow his teachings to guide our actions, decisions, and relationships? The authority of Jesus isn't meant to stifle us but to set us free from the bondage of sin and lead us into the fullness of life. Let us open our hearts to the trans-formative power of Jesus' authority. Let us invite him into the areas of our lives where we need healing and liberation. May God Bless You.


