

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel passage from Mark 1:14-20 marks a pivotal moment in the ministry of our Lord Jesus Christ. As we delve into these verses, we witness the commencement of Jesus' public ministry and the transformative encounter with the first disciples. The passage begins with the proclamation of Jesus: "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news." These words echo through the ages, inviting us to reflect on the ever-present call to repentance and belief. Jesus announces a new era, a kingdom breaking into our world – a kingdom of grace, love, and redemption.

Imagine the scene by the Sea of Galilee: Jesus walks along the shore, and he sees Simon and Andrew casting their nets. His invitation is simple yet profound: "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." At that moment, these fishermen are faced with a decision that will alter the course of their lives forever. What strikes me in this passage is the immediacy of their response. "Immediately they left their nets and followed him." It's a powerful reminder that when Jesus calls, there is no room for hesitation. It calls us to examine our own lives and consider how promptly and wholeheartedly we respond to the call of Christ. James and John, sons of Zebedee, share a similar response – leaving their father and their livelihood behind to follow Jesus. The call of Christ often requires leaving the familiar, stepping into the unknown, and trusting in His divine plan for our lives. As we reflect on this passage, let us ponder the relevance of Jesus' call to us today. Are there nets in our lives that need to be left behind? Are there things holding us back from fully following Christ? The call to repentance and belief is an ongoing invitation to surrender ourselves to the transformative power of Christ. In conclusion, let us embrace the immediacy of the disciples' response. Like them, may we leave behind whatever hinders us and follow Jesus wholeheartedly. The kingdom of God is near – let us repent, believe in the good news, and embark on this journey of discipleship with courage and faith. May God bless you all.

A Minute with the Deacon

Jesus begins his ministry in a startling way announcing the time of fulfillment and the arrival of the kingdom of God. After living quietly during his childhood and early adult years, Jesus, now, draws all attention to himself by announcing this revelation.

When God approaches, we become very aware of our unworthiness to be in His presence and so the first thing we must do is repent. Repent of what?

Repent of all the times we've rejected Him, repent of our indifference to Him, repent of our self-centeredness, repent of our ingratitude toward Him.

Then Jesus tells us to believe in the gospel. In other words, believe in the good new of God's love for us or in other words, believe in him. Jesus is only one who is worthy of belief because He is Truth itself.

As Jesus called his first disciples, he also calls us to be his present-day disciples. If we are going to be worthy of so great a calling, we must first do what he commands: Repent and Believe in Him.

Believing in Jesus frees us from all the false beliefs of the world.

We then become truly capable of becoming his disciples helping to make manifest and grow the kingdom of God in our world.
