

Thank you for all your support Pantry Staff Dear parishioners,

It is a little daunting to be named pastor of our three large city-parishes with their schools, and yet I have a lot of confidence and hope. Let me share with you my "reasons to have hope": first, I'm not alone. I have the assistance of Fr. Kyle and Fr. O'Connor as brother priests and housemates. As brothers with the shared identity as priests of Jesus and the mission to sanctify God's people through the sacraments, we have clear purpose and mission that we can live out together.

Second, we have the assistance and prayers of the whole people of God here in Albany, with all of us, so many faithful members of Christ's body, with so many gifts and talents, so that we make up where each other lacks. We are not alone; together, we carry the faith, our beliefs, our capacity for love, charity, and forgiveness.

Third, I answer my original scriptural quote from St. Peter's exhortation in his first letter (1 Peter 3:15) with another scriptural quote, one which I have relied upon so much that I have selected it as one of readings for my funeral (not that that is any time soon!): "I will call this to mind as my reason to have hope: the favors of the Lord are not exhausted, his mercies are not spent; they are renewed each morning." (Lamentations 3:22)

Our calling as followers of Christ is both comforting and challenging, as I was regularly reminded by one of my first mentors. Yes, we are being shepherded to greener pastures, but we have a lot of important work to do along the way. With hope in Jesus, I am comfortable in knowing that not all is lost, and as hard as it might be, Jesus is also, even primarily, pulling the weight. Let us make our contributions to the ministry, calling, and indeed sufferings of Jesus, and together joyfully progress together towards our heavenly homeland.
